

Blue Band Books

At blue level, your child may now:

- Be able to blend more complex words such as CVCC (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant e.g. mend, lost)
- Be able to blend more complex words such as CCVC (consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant e.g. drum, pram).
- Use the 42 units of sound to read and write words.
- Recognise a greater number of tricky words by sight.

I can read for meaning.

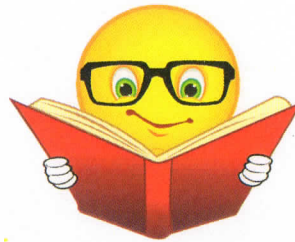
I can self-correct myself more quickly.

I can solve new words by using the pictures and information from the book.

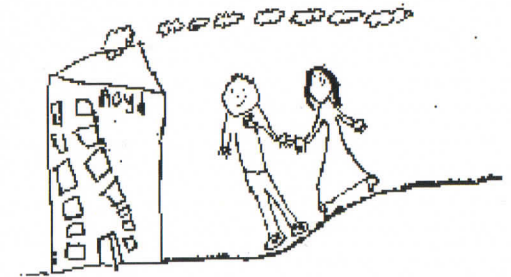
I can show some of the features I may find in a non-fiction and fiction book.

I can tell you something about characters and events using pictures and information from the book.

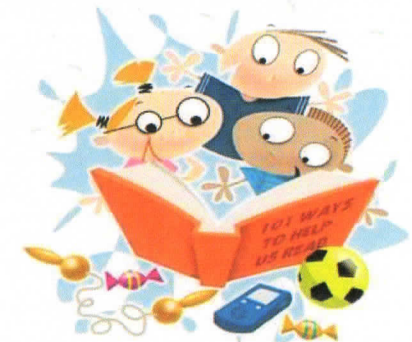


During shared and guided reading sessions we work with your child to achieve the targets above. Please work on these when you read with your child at home
