At orange level, your child is working on:

- Recognise phase 3 graphemes.
- Learning to read CVCC and CCVC words (e.g. went / stop)
- Reading phase 3 tricky words.
- Have some experience in reading 2 syllable words (e.g. picnic, bedroom).
- Recognise different spellings of the same sound e.g. day rain

Our Orange Targets

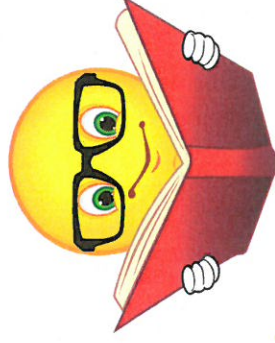
I can read longer and more detailed sentences.

I can say how full stops are used and I am beginning to understand what ! and ? mean.

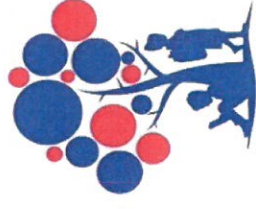
I can begin to sound out words and use familiar phonemes to help me.
