At pale blue level, your child is working on:

- Reading phase 3 tricky words.
- Learning to read CVCC and CCVC words (e.g. went/stop)
- Have some experience in reading 2 syllable words (e.g. picnic, bedroom).
- Recognise different spellings of the same sound e.g. day, rain.

I can find the meaning of a book without pictures.

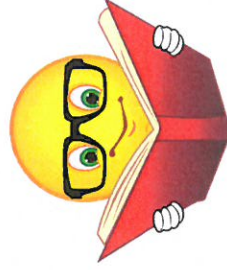
I can start to read different style of books.

I can read punctuation in order to read with expression.

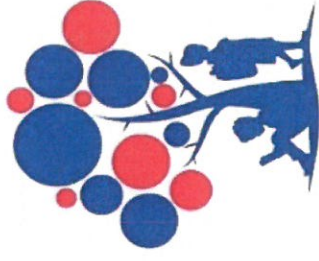
I can read longer books.

During shared and guided reading sessions we work with your child to achieve the targets above. Please work on these when you read with your child at home

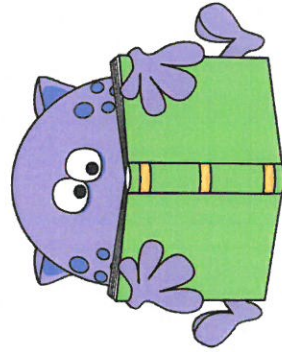
