PE Kit – Deepcar St John's

There has been some improvement in recent weeks – thank you. Please remember to bring kits at the start of the half term and then take them home for washing regularly. Moving forward, we will continue to contact parents/carers by phone asking them to bring PE kit in on the days when children do not have one. Last week we had an issue with indoor plimsolls and trainers, and several children had to do PE in bare feet alongside children with trainers which is not ideal from a safety point of view.

We also have children who do not have an outdoor PE kit in school. PE Kit consists of White T shirt, Navy shorts, Navy jogging bottoms, a jacket and trainers/indoor pumps. Please label all items.

Children with long hair are required to tie this up for PE lessons, you must provide a bobble for your child. We have gone through over 300 since September.

A big thank you to all those parents/carers that always ensure their child comes into school with the correct PE kit.
