This Week

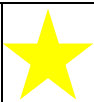

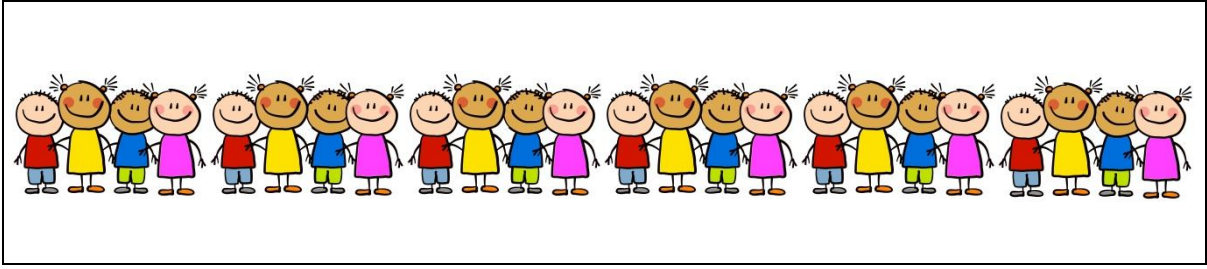
Reminders
