### **Hot Weather Arrangements – Wednesday 24th to Friday 26th June 2026**

Dear Parents and Carers,

With the hot weather forecast to continue for the remainder of the week, we would like to offer **non-school uniform on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday** to help keep children as comfortable as possible during the school day.

Please note that children should still be dressed **appropriately for school**. Suitable clothing includes lightweight, cool clothing or their PE kit. We ask that clothing remains practical and suitable for learning and play, and that shoulders remain covered where possible to help protect children from the sun.

**Year 6 pupils should not wear their leavers' hoodies to school during this hot weather.**

To ensure children remain safe and comfortable in the sun, please can you support us with the following:

- Children should bring a **labelled water bottle** to school each day.
- Please apply **sun cream before school**.
- If your child can apply their own sun cream, they may bring a **named bottle of sun cream** in their bag for reapplication during the day.
- Children are encouraged to bring a **labelled sun hat** to wear during outdoor activities.
- For non-school uniform, please ensure children wear clothing that is suitable for school and made from lightweight, cool materials where possible.
- **Footwear must remain in line with our uniform policy**. Open-toe sandals, sliders and Crocs are not permitted. Children should wear closed-toe footwear for safety.

Please note that children attending **Royd Infant School, the Rainbow Room and the Two-Year-Old Provision** are based in air-conditioned rooms. Parents should ensure that children are dressed appropriately for these cooler indoor environments as well as the warm weather outside.

We would also like to make parents aware that **hay fever levels are particularly high at the moment**. If your child suffers from hay fever, we recommend that they take their usual antihistamine medication before attending school, where appropriate.

Thank you for your support in helping us keep all children safe, comfortable and ready to learn during the warmer weather.
